

OPEN BELGIAN CHAMPIONSHIP “Flying Junior, FJ” 24 & 25 SEPTEMBER 2015

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by :

- 1.1 The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016, issued by ISAF.
- 1.2 The *Reglement Belgische Kampioenschappen* , 01/05/2011, issued by KBYV.
- 1.3 The Flying Junior *Class Rules*.
- 1.4 Appendix P "Special Procedures for Rule 42" will apply with changes to include; allowing a jury initiated redress, a points penalty for a first penalty given after finishing and to prohibit a boat that has been disqualified for a rule 42 infringement or has retired in recognition of a rule 42 infringement from sailing in the race if that race is restarted or resailed

If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. Belgian boats displaying advertising shall present the ‘advertising certificate’ at the entry and registration time.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats and helmsman registered by their national FJ association, and by their national authority. Belgian competitors will present their sailing license at entry registration.
- 3.2 To enter the championship eligible boats have to complete the entry form and pay the required fee. Entry forms will be available on september 26th at the race office.

4 FEES

Required fees are as follows: 15 €.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Entry and registration : Saturday September 24th : 10:00 to 11:30.
- 5.2 First warning signal : Saturday September 24th : 12:00.
- 5.3 First warning signal on Sunday 25th will be presented on the notice board before 19:00 on Saturday.
- 5.4 No warning signal will be given after 15:00 on Sunday; unless this warning signal and race validates the Belgian Championship.
- 5.5 Number of races scheduled : 7 Decision or failure of the race committee to reach this number shall not be ground for redress.
- 5.6 Prize giving : As soon as possible after the last race on Sunday.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat possesses a valid measurement certificate and shall produce this at request of the Jury.

7 VENUE

Lake Galgenweel (left bank Antwerp, Belgium)
Beatrijslaan 93, 2050 Antwerpen, Belgium.

8 THE COURSES

Courses will be triangular including upwind, downwind beats and reaches.

9 SCORING

If 4 or more races are completed the worst score will not count, unless this score is a penalty that cannot be discarded.

10 SOCIAL EVENTS

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the first 3 competitors. If the regatta is validated by the KBYV Winner will receive the title ‘Belgisch Kampioen Flying Junior klasse 2016’

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EURO 1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
